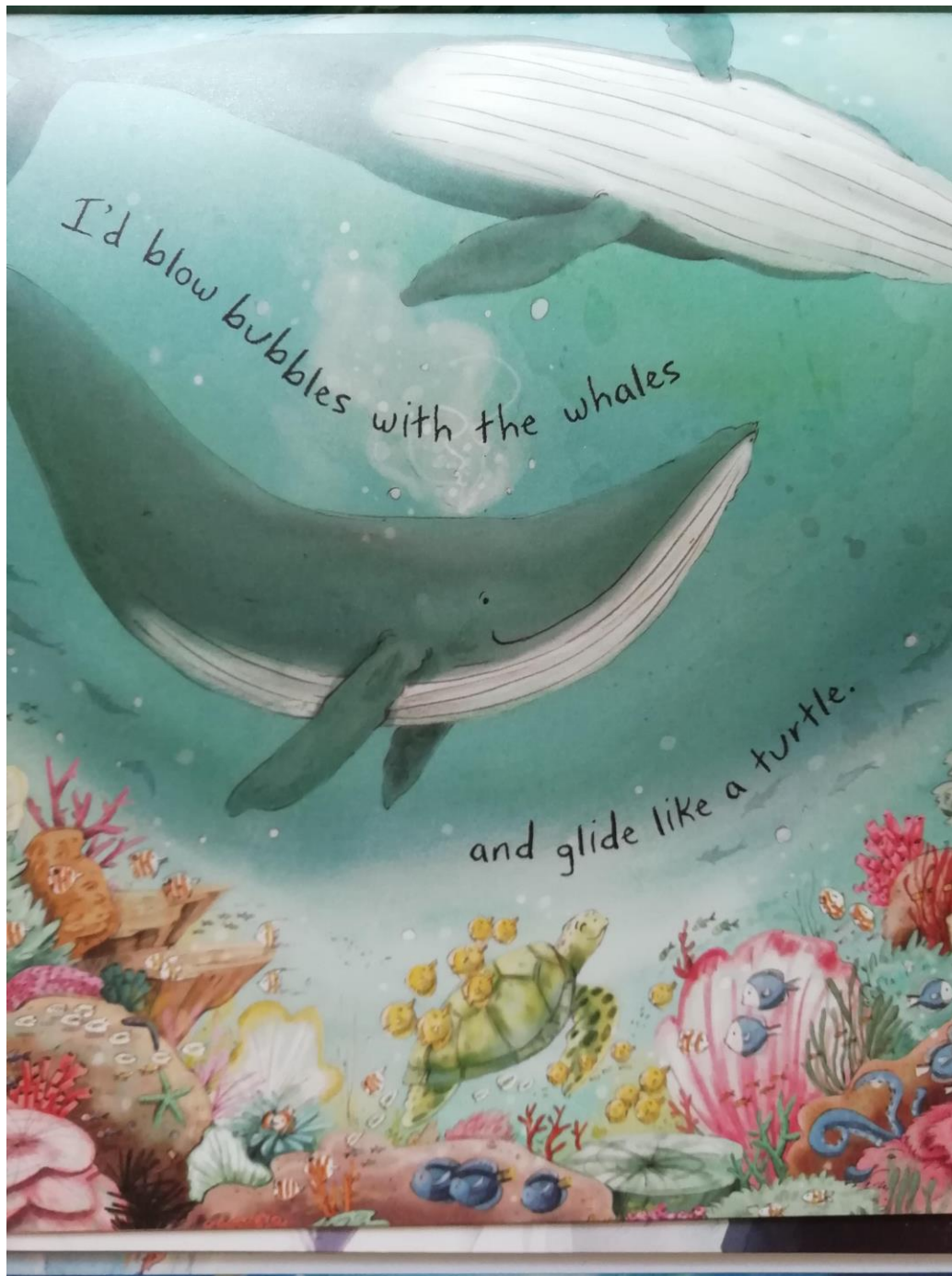


Most of your surface

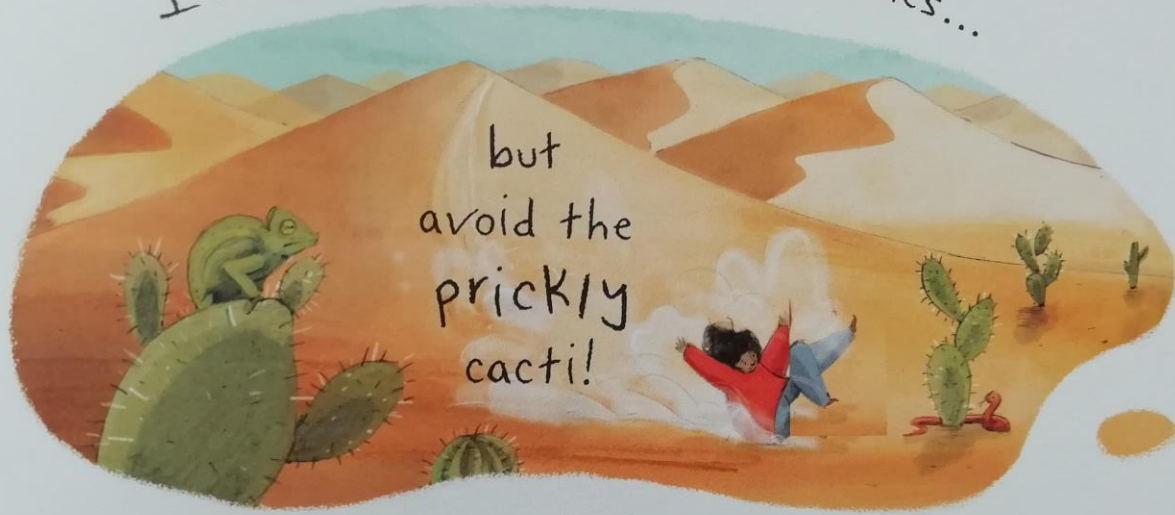
Part of you is
