Thursday	<p>Reading Read to an adult for 5-10 minutes. Remember the online libraries if you are running out of books at home. Once you have decoded the words always remember to go back and say the whole sentence. This will help you to become more fluent. Remember to talk about what you have read.</p> <p>Writing Today, I would like you to describe a Chinese Dragon. You may choose to make one from a paper plate (see today's wider curriculum learning) or colour in the mask from the resources. Write a sentence to go alongside your dragon. Talk about centimetres are the standard measurement for height. Show your child a ruler or tape measure and how cm are marked out.</p> <p>*** same as * and ** but also use a ruler/tape measure to measure the height of the object on the sheet to the nearest centimetre.
