Monday	<p>This week we are revising all Phase 3 sounds and tricky words, as we have now learnt them all. Children will be assessed in school and parents will be sent the sounds and words their child needs to practice.</p> <p>Recap all Phase 3 sounds in sound book. Children read: The pen is black. Children write, using phoneme fingers: I am at the park.</p>	<p>Watch SuperKid (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=NttRkk4WcCA).</p> <p>What were the problems? Has anyone ever had to be rescued? Lost, fallen off scooter, been sick? Who was the Superhero that 'rescued' them? Have they ever been a Superhero to one of their friends?</p> <p>Role play being SuperKid or someone in trouble. Lesson 1 - Session 1 - Which show 6? - Composition of 6 on Vimeo</p> <p>Go on a '6' hunt looking for different representations of 6.. What is the most unexpected place that you found it?</p>	<p>Scarf- Listening to my feelings. Happy, sad, not sure scenarios</p> <p>Taking each of the 15 scenarios listed below, ask the children to say whether they think it's safe, not safe, or they're not sure. Encourage children to make up their own minds, rather than copying others, by explaining that we all have different feelings - and that they are not right or wrong:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● crossing a busy road ● playing in the garden ● climbing high up in a tree ● walking along the top of a high wall ● cycling along a pavement ● playing a board game with Grandma ● getting lost in the supermarket ● swimming/jumping in at the deep end ● playing football in the park with the big children ● putting your shoes on ● playing at the skate park with the big children ● watching telly on the sofa ● travelling in the back of the car
