Have a go at these techniques: Wet the paper before you add paint. This is great for creating backgrounds Sprinkle some salt on the paint when it's nearly dry. Not much! Once it's dry, remove the salt by brushing gently. Try removing some wet paint using a tissue. This works well to create clouds in the sky if you start with a blue background. Otherwise there's some step by step drawings to have a go at.</p>
