

These sentences are not in the subjunctive mood. It is vital that you rewrite them so that they are!

Section 1: These ones are nearly in the subjunctive but there is an error. Can you find it and explain it? No need to copy the corrected version as many would be identical to each other.

Example explanation: "In number 1, the word 'be' is missing".

1. Alec insisted that he given the biggest slice.
2. Alec insisted that he was given the biggest slice.
3. Alec insisted that he be gave the biggest slice.
4. Alec insist that he be given the biggest slice.
5. A suggestion was made that the choir sang another song.
6. It is advisable that he goes to the doctor.

Section 2: These are not in the subjunctive at all. Rewrite them using the subjunctive.

1. I suggested that we should go on holiday to France.
2. She requested that her sister left her bedroom.
3. The headteacher made a proposal that all children should wear their coats.
4. My aunt issued an order saying that the building work should be completed promptly.
5. All dogs must be kept on leads. (Use the the adjective *imperative*)
6. They didn't want to miss the train (Use the adjective *anxious*)
