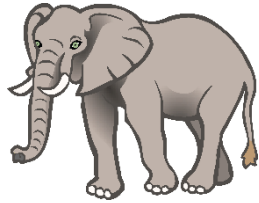
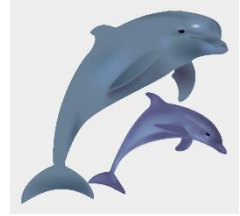


Kit and Sam's Animal Adventure

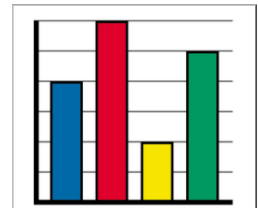


Philip took lots of photos of the elephants splashing water and of the dolphins being fed by the zookeeper. "I wish we could get closer," said Kit.
