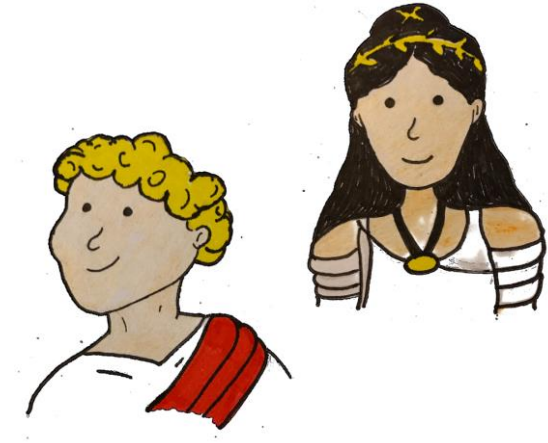


I can identify and use adverbs of manner and time.
