Narrative Poetry (The Promise) Overview and outcomes: Children will discuss the concept of promises, making their own and exploring how a seed can hold a promise within. Children will investigate the impact of using a range of modal verbs and specific punctuation choices, as well as building their vocabulary to create figurative phrases to write poetry. The Writing Root will culminate in children writing their own sequel in the form of a narrative poem to continue the story cycle.
